Day 1 – May 11 środa/Wed.

- 10³⁰ Pick up Group at the Airport and go to Old Town in Warsaw.
- 11⁰⁰ Visit to Royal Castle and Old Town.
- 14³⁰ Lunch followed by continued visit of Warsaw
- 17³⁰ Departure to Sierpc.
- 19³⁰ Arrival and Check into hotel in Sierpc. Supper

Note: This hotel has a sauna, pool and bowling alleys
